



Southwark - Summer Residence

Southwark Residence is situated in London Travel Zone 1 in the heart of London.

Description of Local Area

In the heart of London, Southwark Residence is located near Waterloo International Station and near London Bridge. This is one of the most densely populated and multi-cultural areas in the capital. Surrounded by restaurants, pubs, cinemas (including IMAX), the residence is close to the river and within walking distance of many of London's major attractions.

Description of Accommodation

The bedrooms are arranged into flats of 5 rooms, which share a large kitchen. Each bedroom has an ensuite shower, WC and basin and is equipped with a bed, desk, chair and lots of storage space. The residence has 24-hour reception / security. The residence includes vending machines for snacks and a common room with a TV where students can socialise. Additionally, there is a garden where students can enjoy the summer sun.

Journey to school	The quickest way to EC London is by bus. Walk to Waterloo station (10 minutes) and take a bus (1, 68, 168, 171, 188 or X68) from the bus stop opposite the London IMAX cinema (big round building) to Holborn Station. On leaving the bus, turn right and walk up Kingsway. Turn left at the traffic lights and walk up High Holborn, past Sainsbury's Supermarket. Take the second road on your left off High Holborn (Smart's Place) and then turn right into Stukeley Street. The school entrance is on the right hand side of the road. The total journey time is approximately 30 minutes.

Cancellations

Cancellation prior to arrival

Students cancelling their accommodation fewer than 14 days before arrival will be charged a one week accommodation fee – charged at the standard accommodation rate and accommodation placement fee.

Cancellation after arrival
