This linguistical, methodological and sociocultural course has been designed for foreign French teachers living outside France. The FPF course is intended for active teachers of French as a foreign language or students of this domain at the end of their cycle.









Objectifs FG :

- Improve your communicational skills by focusing on oral interactions
- Interact in everyday situations(using these newly acquired skills)
- Develop your know-how and social skills in an international environment
- Obtain fluency and the confidence to communicate in French

- The knowledge and ability of using French as a teaching and learning language
- Update skills of sociocultural realities of contemporary France
- Classroom practice and more generally methodology applying to the teaching of French as a language of communication
- Enrichment of practical skills and teaching tools
- Exchange of classroom best practice

TEACHERS	All our teachers have degrees in teaching French as a Foreign Language (FLE) and receive ongoing training to develop their teaching techniques. They alternately lead and co-ordinate the lessons in each group according to your objectives.					
FG GROUP PLACEMENT	On official starting dates, each new student will do a written and oral evaluation in order to organize the FG groups.					
CERTIFICATE	Each participant receives, on the day of their departure, a certificate indicating the duration and the level of the taken course based on the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).					



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Units on French society:

A language fits completely into the society that carries it. Language of communication above all, it also serves to exchange about facts, phenomena, evolutions that crosses this society. The unit "French society" will allow you both to update your knowledge about the state of contemporary French society and the prospect of enrolling this knowledge in your French classes. Social facts, cultural facts, political facts and others will be addressed, dealt with through varied and updated support documents that can later find their place in your teaching practices.

Pedagogical units:

The language class is the place where our teaching skills are expressed. It is also a complex place where class activities, animation, pedagogy, didactic dimensions together hold a central place. The "pedagogical" units offer you the opportunity to benefit from the field experience of our teachers in this domain. But also to be able to share your own experience and class practices in a principle of exchange and sharing.

Different themes will be proposed: Use of authentic supports, evaluation practices, play activities, implementation of class projects are some possible examples.

Each module aims to be as interactive as possible in order to provide you with practical tools for the class and to exchange together on your practices and on your class experiences. The teachers who will facilitate these workshops will share their approaches and experiences of the language class in order to provide you with new ideas and energies at the service of your work as a teacher of French.
