Do you need to lecture or teach in English to international student groups? Gain essential tips for preparing and delivering engaging and effective lectures.

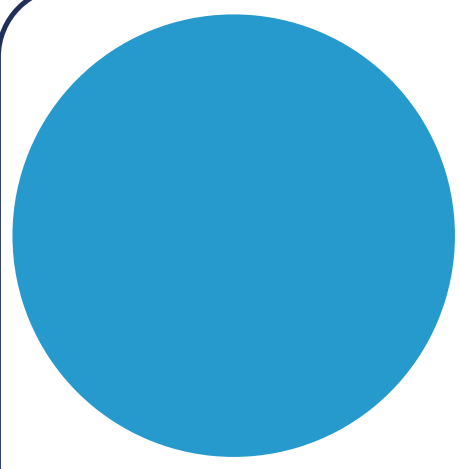
Course Outline
