Participants also have the opportunity to share ideas and collaborate with fellow staff from around Europe, whilst enjoying Irish culture in one of Ireland's most vibrant cities.

- Workshop sessions to analyse and explore situations pertinent to the education sector.
- Cultural and heritage trips as part of a chaperoned group

Expected outcomes and impact

This course provides a professional development opportunity for participants which aims to enhance their ability to work effectively in or build a team. Through focused workshops, collaborative sessions, and group projects, participants are invited to share the knowledge and skills they have acquired with their colleagues. Sharing ideas and collaborating with fellow Education staff from around Europe is a further positive outcome.

Cultural Programme

The courses are delivered at Atlantic Centre of Education in Galway on Ireland's 'Wild Atlantic' Coast, and participants will have ample opportunity to learn about the cultural heritage of both Ireland and the local area. The week-long programme includes a full-day cultural tour to a local area of scenic and heritage value, a guided historical walking tour of Galway city, and afternoon social and cultural activities.
