This engaging 50+ course combines English language learning with an exploration of Devon's rich history, culture, and landscapes. Designed for students who want to improve their English while discovering fascinating local sites, the course enhances vocabulary, speaking, listening, and writing skills in real-world contexts.

Our programme combines an intensive General English course, taught in classes of 6 students maximum, with engaging excursions around the UK's most varied, beautiful and evocative region.

Improve your English in the morning, and in the afternoon enjoy activities and excursions around some of the places and attractions that have made Devon so famous.

Your fellow travellers will be of a similar age, background and interests.

By the end of the course, students will feel more confident using English in everyday situations and have a deeper appreciation of Devon's unique character. Whether enjoying a cream tea, visiting ancient castles, or strolling along dramatic coastlines, students will develop the language skills they need to make the most of their experience in this beautiful part of England.
