



ENGLISH FOR PROFESSIONALS



This course is aimed at students who work in English, and want to develop their communication skills for the 21st Century workplace.

Our EFP course is ideal for those working on or looking to work and live through English. Afternoon classes are in small groups (avg. 6 students) and conducted in a Project Based approach to allow for maximum interaction



NETWORKING

Each week concludes with a coffee afternoon, where students get the chance to network, swap contacts and discuss potential future collaboration.



ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

Private, ensuite accommodation as well as VIP Host Family with private bathroom are the most popular options for our EFP students.



VIVA SOCIAL

Although the 25 hour programme is an intense academic week, there is still time for students to discover Dublin. Evening activities, our Friday afternoon excursion, and weekend trips all allow students to experience unique Irish culture.

FAST-PACED AND INTERACTIVE













Classes follow CEFR levels with inhouse objectives, covering all four skills plus grammar and pronunciation. Weekly assessments and Irish culture segments are included, with notes and resources on Google Classroom.



SUPPORT

Students benefit from free weekly Academic Tutorials, a Student Care Manager for support with social life and services, and (from B1 level) free twice-weekly IELTS Tutorials.



ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

Stay at Viva Residence in the city centre or choose a South Dublin host family for full immersion.

Ideal for students looking to blend communication with culture, this course allows you to improve your English and explore Dublin.









10-WEEK HOLIDAY PERIOD

All students registered on the Work & Study programmes are eligible to take 10 weeks of holiday at the end of their 25-week course. This is the ideal time to visit and explore Ireland and other neighbouring European countries such as Italy, Spain, Portugal and France.

Protection of Enrolled Learner (PEL) and private Medical Insurances are a requirement for Work & Study Programme students.




LEAP CARD

Work & Study students can apply for a Student Leap Card which will give them discounted prices when using Public Transportation.




JOB CLUB

TEACHER TRAINING

The Linguaviva Centre provides year round Teacher Training, specializing in Erasmus + Courses for Overseas Teachers which are eligible for EU funding. We have four options to choose from all of which combine English classes (50%) delivered by experienced professional teachers with training content aimed at teachers (50%) to refresh and revitalize your teaching whether you are a language teacher or teach other content such as Science or Geography.

COMMUNICATE TO EDUCATE: COMMUNICATIVE LANGUAGE TEACHING FOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS

Our popular Communicate to Educate: Communicative Language Teaching for Secondary Schools (B1 to C2 levels) course for teachers who wish to deliver some or all of their classroom content through English, and wish their language classes to be as communicative as possible. We ask Teachers on this course to bring access to their academic course materials with them and we show them how to design, deliver and develop CLIL material with a communicative focus.

CULTURAL HERITAGE (TWO CITIES: MANY STORIES)

Cultural Heritage (Two Cities: Many Stories) is a course for educators who want to introduce Cultural Heritage into their classes (B1 to C2 levels). We provide entertaining lesson plans and materials based on Irish Culture & History at all three major levels of the CEFR. We also focus on Teaching. This course links academic content directly with educational tours and activities.

TRINITY CERT TESOL

The **Trinity CertTESOL** is an internationally recognised teaching qualification for new or aspiring English teachers, as well as those seeking formal certification. It equips trainees with essential skills, practical classroom techniques, and insight into learner challenges and the teacher's role. Rated Level 5 on Ofqual's framework (equivalent to year two of a degree), it is recognised in Ireland as a Level 8 Special Award. We offer this course both online and in person.
