OUR APPROACH

At the heart of ALC's success is the Maliha Wehbe Method. With experience in teaching Arabic as a foreign language since 1967, Maliha developed a simplified and intuitive approach to help students learn and speak Arabic naturally—using Arabic script rather than English transliteration. This unique method reveals the logic of the language in both its oral and written forms, presenting it in a clear and structured way that has not been implemented before. It makes the learning process more accessible and gives Arabic the recognition it deserves—as a logical, systematic, and approachable language.

Our method of teaching Arabic facilitates students first grasping the oral communication skills before getting into the Classical Arabic. We teach the Levant Dialect, a form of Arabic used by various Arab nationals combined with the Modern Standard Arabic; the latter being a standard form recognised all over the Arab World. We concentrate on allowing our students to approximate a native speaker of the language.



Instruction.

At ALC, we utilize an interactive, communicative and student-centered approach that focuses on real life communication. Teaching the four skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing – with a focus on speaking, using a variety of drills, role-plays and classroom task-based activities that promote student-student interaction.

Classes are structured into Beginners, Intermediate & Advanced levels. Our curriculum and teaching approach promote meaningful communication and enable learners to perform real-life functions effectively. Along with this, ALC has prepared students for international examinations. The effectiveness of our programmes can be judged by the outstanding achievement of our students, maintaining a history of 100% success rate in international external examinations.

Students are taken step by step through the language in an informal, relaxed atmosphere and the courses are constantly reviewed, updated and improved to meet the needs of the students and incorporate new teaching experiences.
