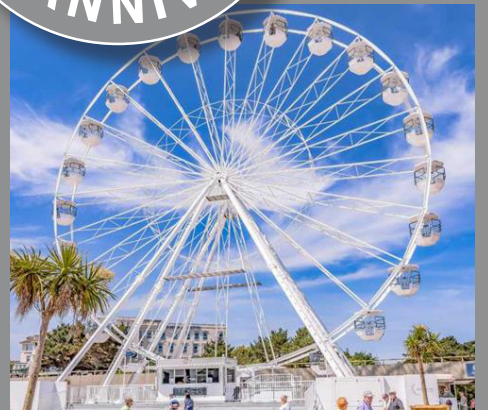

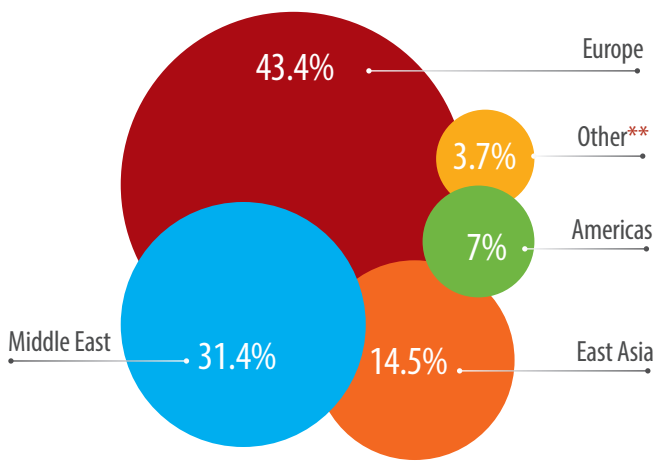

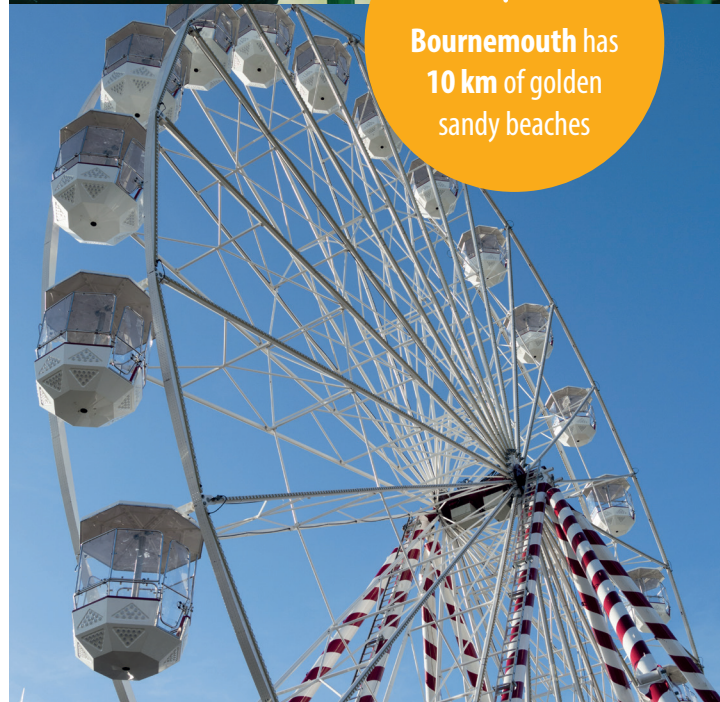

YOUR FIRST DAY

You will be welcomed to the school by our Academic and Accommodation/Welfare teams. We will give you a test to find your English level. You will log on to BEET Online, access the Student Guide and can start studying online straightaway.

On *preferred start dates you will have a Welcome Meeting where you get to know the other new students, find out important information about the school and get some tips on living in England. You will also have a coach tour of the local area.

HOMEWORK AND SELF-STUDY

Homework forms an important part of your course. The amount depends on the type of course you are following, but you should expect to do 1 to 3 hours a week on a General English course. If you are in an exam class, it will be more! We also believe that self-study is very helpful - with our library and two computer rooms, there are many opportunities to use your own time to focus on those areas you want to make even quicker progress in.

YOUR LAST DAY

On your last day, you will receive a Certificate of Studies, provided your attendance and performance are satisfactory. This certificate makes an assessment of your level and comments on your progress during your course. Students on an International Academic Year course receive a Diploma.

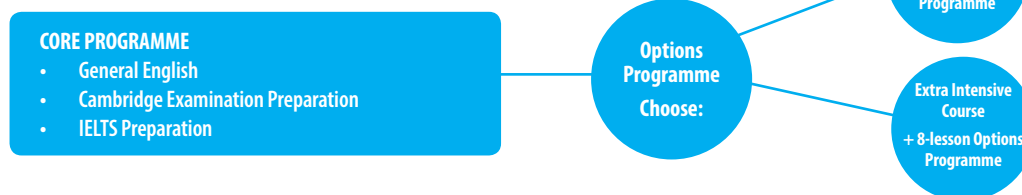




How Our Courses Work

TIMETABLE

Your Core lessons are normally in the morning, from 09:00 to 12:20. Options are then between 13:00 and 14:30.

Occasionally, during busy periods, we operate a zigzag timetable. This means your Core lessons will be in the morning one day, starting at 09:00, and in the afternoon the next day, starting at 14:30. Options remain in the middle of the day, between 12:45 and 14:15.

PLEASE NOTE:

All 45-minute lessons are combined to form 90-minute sessions.
